What parent support is needed for students learning at home?

- Parents must complete an orientation prior to students gaining access to course materials.
- Parents will work with their local school to ensure student has access to a compatible device and Internet services.
- Parents must log their younger students in each day or ensure that they can log in on their own.
- Parents should assist students with navigation and learning support as needed.
- Parents should communicate frequently with their teacher.

What support will IDLA provide students learning at home?

- A certified teacher.
- Research-based curriculum in ELA and Math aligned to Idaho Content Standards.
- Technical support for parents and students.
- Parent/Student Orientation.
- Regular progress reports to the parent and local school contact with student achievement data.
